Tuition:

- Monday and Wednesday Early Learning - \$300
- Tuesday and Thursday Early Learning - \$300
- Friday Early Learning - \$150
- Monday Nature Skills I - \$160
- Wednesday Nature Skills I - \$160
- Friday Nature Skills II - \$160

Payment Information

Payments will be due the 1st of the month. There will be a 5% late fee for payments made after the 5th of the month.

Check : We do not accept money at school. Please write a check with the child's name in the note and mail to: Olympic Nature Experience, PO Box 688, Carlsborg, WA 98324

Online Banking: If you are enrolled for online banking with your bank institution, take advantage by paying for school fees. Once you schedule a payment, a check will be sent to us in the mail. Just go to Bill Pay and add Olympic Nature Experience as a payee. **This year, due to possible Covid-19 closures, please do not set up an autopay for the entire school year through your bank, if you would like to set up autopay, use our website (see below) instead.**

PayPal/Credit Card: Visit our website for one time and monthly payment set up <https://www.olympicnatureexperience.org/tuition-payments/> If setting up recurring payments through our subscription option you must do so before October 5th or your payments will be considered late. Recurring payments will end in April and a final invoice will be sent in May with total amount due.

Covid-19 Closures and Tuition

If we close at any point in the month, tuition will be kept for that month only. No tuition will be due until students return to school.

Deposits will be equal to one month's tuition and will apply to May's tuition. If we close the school year before May, we will keep your family's deposit unless you request it back due to financial hardship.

Please note we will NOT be accepting payments in full for the 2020-2021 school year due to potential Covid-19 closures.

Financial Hardship

We understand that finances are less predictable for some during the current covid-19 outbreak. If you run into financial hardship during the school year, please contact us immediately so we can create a payment plan, help you apply for tuition assistance or otherwise find a way to continue your child's learning with us.

If you withdraw your student from programs during the school year, we will keep your deposit unless we can fill your spot within 2 weeks or if you request it back due to financial hardship.
